You have the chance to work towards more advanced skills when you and your dog are ready (Stepping Up and Stepping Out).

We train in the real world, focusing on practical real-world behaviors – teaching your dog to stay calm, to listen to you, and to be your partner, along with behaviors such as sit, stay, walk on a loose leash and other things you need!

Advancement to the next level of training class is achieved by passing an end of class skills test. That assures that you and your dog are not pushed too quickly before having the chance to build a solid foundation of skills as a dog and handler team. Our program is designed for success — and having FUN getting there!

Positive Reinforcement R+ training methods reward our dog's good behavior with something he likes — a yummy treat, a fun toy, playtime, praise. We do not punish bad behavior. We redirect our dog's behavior by teaching him how to do something good instead.
